FAQ

DISCRETION

Your application and design proposal will not be showed to other persons than the jury members. The jury members maintain full professional discretion.

COPYRIGHT

The copyright of your design project belongs only to you. And if you are granted the award, the copyright still belongs to you. Normann Copenhagen only serves as exhibition facility and is not under obligation to produce the project afterwards.

DESIGN PROPOSAL OR FINISHED PROJECT

It is up to your self to decide whether you want to apply with a design proposal or if you need to modify a more finished project. The criteria are that you will be in need of the facilities at the National Workshops. In other words: the actual design project for the exhibition is to be carried out and produced at the workshops.

MORE THAN ONE PROJECT

An application can only include one project, but it is possible to send in more than one application. Every project must be in a separate application if you decide to do so.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

It is important that you describe your proposal as detailed as possible to make it easier for the jury to determine the quality of the project. If you have ideas about the type of materials and production methods, please write it. Some kind of attached visual material like drawings, sketches or photos are required in order to judge the application.

CAREER COACHING

The type of career coaching depends on the needs of the actual winner of Time to design. Career coaching can include help to e.g. business plan, communication and exposure.

ALONE – OR TOGETHER

You may apply together with a partner. If you and your partner intend to work together on the proposed project, please make sure that your individual competences and design skills will be clear to the jury.
